Simple Past chapter 5

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When do we use this tense in English?

Use the <u>simple past</u> for action that happened in the past and is:

over, done, finished!



Grammar has meaning!

Different grammar tenses are used in different situations or contexts and they carry different meanings.

For example . .

Compare the <u>meaning</u> of these two sentences:

- 1. Sara <u>lived</u> in Boston for 5 years.
- 2. Sara <u>has lived</u> in Boston for 5 years.

The first sentence uses: Simple Past

The second sentence uses: Present Perfect

Sara <u>lived</u> in Boston for 5 years.

<u>Meaning</u>: by using the simple past tense, we mean that Sara started living in Boston 5 years ago . . .

AND . . . then she <u>moved</u>! Now she lives in a different city, like Paris.

Remember, the simple past is used for a situation that is over, finished, done!

Sara <u>has lived</u> in Boston for 5 years.

<u>Meaning:</u> by using the present perfect tense, we mean that Sara began living in Boston 5 years ago .

AND . . . she <u>still</u> lives there.

Remember, present perfect: <u>connects</u> the past with the present.

Use the <u>simple past</u> with time words like:

- yesterday
- **last** Saturday, week, month, year, etc.
- _____ ago
- when I was...
- in 1990 (past date)



For example :

Ali <u>covered</u> the floor with flowers. We <u>played</u> football yesterday. I <u>went</u> to school yesterday.


Negative Sentences :

<u>Subject</u> + <u>auxiliary</u> verb + not +verb base did

For example : we watched the match yesterday we did not watch the match yesterday He tried to swim last night He didn't try to swim last night



<u>auxiliary verb + subject + verb base</u> did For example : Did you go to London? Did they work at home? Where did you meet ana last week? How did you make a cake?



Remember!

If you are talking about a specific time in the past (yesterday, last month, etc.), you <u>cannot</u> use the present perfect.

In these cases, use the simple past.
